

ORDINANCE NO. 85-4

AN ORDINANCE ABANDONING A ROAD IN FANNETT
TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED That the Supervisors of Fannett Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

I.

That part of a road running through the lands now or formerly of Robert W. Cody and Elisabeth E. C. Cody which begins at a point at a Y intersection of a road known as Hill Road being the western point of the intersection and continuing to the point where the said Hill Road intersects Legislative Route 28011 also known as Pa Route 641 and being a section of road .185 miles in length be abandoned.

II.

The ownership of the said lands shall revert in accordance with the laws of this Commonwealth.

III.

There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance the plan of the foregoing road showing the location thereof.

IV.

Said road shall hereafter cease to be a part of the public road system of Fannett Township.
